Azalea 'Siskin' Yellow Knapp Hill Azalea <i>DECIDUOUS FLOWERING SHRUB; large fragrant yellow flowers in June with a darker blotch; dark green summer foliage; upright habit to 8' tall by 5' wide; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; - 20° F</i>	15 15	36 - 42" 42 - 48"	B&B B&B	N N
Buxus x 'Green Velvet' Hybrid Boxwood <i>EVERGREEN SHRUB; compact globular habit to 4' high and wide; slow grower, but faster than 'Green Gem'; dark evergreen foliage all year; locate in full sun to moderate shade & moisture retentive well-drained organic soil that's neutral to alkaline; PHS Gold Metal [B. microphylla var. koreana x B. sempervirens] (Sheridan Ns) Zones 5 - 8</i>	BUSH V Ltd	18 - 24" spr 24 - 30" spr	B&B B&B

Buxus sempervirens Common Boxwood <i>EVERGREEN SHRUB; dark evergreen foliage; very compact upright habit becomes rounded with age; highly deer browse resistant; locate in full sun to moderate shade & moisture retentive well-drained organic soil that's neutral to alkaline; native to Europe, Asia & Africa; Zones 5 - 8</i>	BUSH V Ltd	18 - 24" 24 - 30" 30 - 36"	B&B B&B B&B	
Cornus x Celestial ('Rutdan') White Rutgers Hybrid Dogwood; White Stellar Dogwood <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; white overlapping bracts in mid May; habit is vigorously upright when young, but becomes about as wide as tall when mature; resistant to anthracnose & borers; locate in full sun to partial shade with good organic well-drained soil that's neutral to slightly acidic [C. kousa x C. florida] (Orton) Zones 5 - 7</i>	8 25	7-8' / 1.75" c 8-10' / 2" c	B&B B&B	
Cornus florida 'Cherokee Princess' White Flowering Dogwood <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; profuse large white bracts; red fruit appears in late summer; bright red fall foliage; vigorous upright grower that will get broad with age; locate in full sun to partial shade with good organic well-drained soil that's neutral to slightly acidic; US native; Zones 6 - 9</i>	25 30 5 25	7-8' / 1.5" c 8-10' / 1.75" c 6-7' / 1.25" c 10-12' / 2.5" c	B&B B&B B&B B&B	
Cornus x Venus ('KN30-8') White Rutgers Hybrid Dogwood <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; 6" diameter white flowers in mid-spring; round red fruit in fall; dark green summer foliage turns orange in fall; vigorous grower to 20' tall & wide in 20 years; resistant to powdery mildew, anthracnose & borers; locate in full sun to partial shade with good organic well-drained soil that's neutral to slightly acidic; [C. kousa x C. nuttallii] (Orton) Zones 6 - 8</i>	20 5	7 - 8' 8 - 9'	B&B B&B	N N
Euonymus alatus 'Compacta' Compact Burning Bush <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL SHRUB; upright habit when young; wider than tall with maturity; bright red fall foliage; red seeds in fall; locate in sun or shade; tolerant of any soil that drains; not very drought tolerant; native to Asia; Zones 4 - 8</i>		3 - 4'	B&B

Magnolia x liliiflora 'Jane' USDA Hybrid Lily Magnolia <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; flowers are reddish-purple on the outside & white inside; they appear before the dark green foliage in early to mid spring; locate in full sun or light shade & moist organic well-drained soils of varying acidity; native Asian cross [M. kobus var. stellata 'Waterlily' x M. liliiflora 'Reflorescens'] (USNA - Kosar) Zones 5 - 8</i>		10 6 - 7' 15 7 - 8' 15 8 - 9' 6 9 - 10'	B&B B&B B&B B&B	N N N

Rhododendron 'English Roseum' Pink Hybrid Rhododendron <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; rosy-lavender flower in May; compact grower to about 5' tall in 10 years; very durable; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light shade and deep organic well-drained acidic soils (Waterer) - 25° F</i>		36 - 42" 42 - 48"	B&B B&B	N N

<i>EVERGREEN ORNAMENTAL CONIFER; vigorous narrowly pyramidal habit to 60' tall by 15' wide; bright evergreen foliage; minimal pest or disease problems; somewhat deer browse resistant; locate in full sun or light shade & moist to well-drained soil of varying acidity; tolerant of coastal exposure but not persistent drought; PHS Gold Metal [T. plicata x T. standishii] Zones 5 - 7</i>
