| Abelia x 'Edward Goucher' Pink Abelia <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; evergreen to semi-evergreen foliage; purple-pink flowers all summer; grows to 5' high & wide; attracts butterflies; resists deer browse; locate in full sun & well drained slightly acidic soil; Zones (5) 6 - 9</i> | | | 3g | |
| Abelia x 'Rose Creek' Compact Glossy Abelia <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; clusters of small white flowers from summer to frost; dense spreading habit to 3' tall by 4' wide; new foliage emerges from red stems with pinkish tinge before turning dark glossy green by summer; late fall & winter foliage has a purplish cast; locate in full to partial sun; good moisture retentive organic soil is best; Zones 6 - 9</i> | | | 3g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Beni kawa' Red Bark Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; green spring & summer foliage turns yellow & gold in fall; winter bark is bright red on younger stems; slow, bushy, vase-shaped habit to 5'; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 6 - 7</i> | | | 5g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Bloodgood' Red Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; dark red spring & summer foliage; broadly upright habit to 25' or more in 25 years; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 3g 7g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Butterfly' Variegated Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; green foliage with white margins; pink tones are prevalent in early spring as well; upright vase-shaped habit to 15' or more; fairly slow grower; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 6 - 8</i> | | | 5g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Crimson Prince' Red Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; bright red spring foliage becomes greenish-red by late summer then bright red by mid-fall; broad densely branched upright habit to 20' tall & wide in 10 years; branching starts about 3' or more above grade; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native (Princeton Ns) Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 5g 10g | N |
| Acer palmatum 'Crimson Queen' Red Laceleaf Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; crimson laceleaf foliage into mid-summer; summer foliage is reddish-green, depending on heat, moisture and shade; excellent compact mounding habit; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 10g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Fireglow' Red Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; moderate upright grower; bright red spring & summer foliage; red is almost translucent when viewed looking through them toward the sun; more heat tolerant than most other red cultivars; cultivars; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 10g | N |

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| Acer palmatum 'Orangeola' Laceleaf Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; orange-red spring foliage turns dark green in summer; a second summer flush of orange-red foliage contrasts beautifully with the mature green foliage; compact weeping to spreading mounding habit; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 3g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Red Dragon' Red Laceleaf Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; dark red laceleaf foliage all spring, summer & fall; slow to moderate compact spreading habit; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 3g | |
| Acer palmatum 'Ryusen' Weeping Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; typical green palmatum foliage on a tree with a strictly weeping habit; height dependent on staking; foliage turns bright shades of yellow orange & red in fall; can be left un-staked to trail over walls or rocks; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 5g 10g | N |
| Acer palmatum 'Sango kaku' / 'Senkaki' Coral Bark Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; green spring & summer foliage turns yellow & gold in fall; winter bark is bright red on younger stems; upright vase-shaped habit to 20'; fairly slow grower; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 6 - 7</i> | | | 5g 7g sqt 7g 10g | N |
| Acer palmatum 'Tamukeyama' Red Laceleaf Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; dark red laceleaf holds color well all summer; vigorous spreading habit; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; PHS Gold Metal; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 3g 10g | |
| Achillea 'Strawberry Seduction' Red Yarrow <i>PERENNIAL; dark red flowers with prominent yellow centers from early summer through early fall; compact habit to 20" tall by 24" wide; dark green foliage; attracts butterflies; resists deer & rabbit browse; good cut flower; not tolerant of high humidity & moisture retentive soils; locate in full sun & most well-drained soils; native to Europe &/or Asia (Blooms of B.) Zones (3) 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Achillea 'Sunny Seduction' Yellow Yarrow <i>PERENNIAL; soft yellow flowers with a darker center from early summer through early fall; compact upright habit to 30" tall by 27" wide; gray-green foliage; attracts butterflies; resists deer & rabbit browse; good cut flower; not tolerant of high humidity & moisture retentive soils; locate in full sun & most well-drained soils; native to Europe &/or Asia (Blooms of B.) Zones (3) 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Acorus gramineus 'Oborozuki' Variegated Sweet Flag; Grassy-Leafed Sweet Flag <i>PERENNIAL; golden foliage with green stripes; non-showy yellow flowers in late spring yields fleshy berries; grows from 6" to 12" tall & wide; good for erosion control; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in full to partial sun & moist to wet soils along or slightly in waterways; Asian native; Zones 5 - 8</i> | | | 2g | |

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| Acorus gramineus 'Ogon' Grassy-Leafed Sweet Flag <i>PERENNIAL; fragrant narrow foliage with green & yellow stipples that appears mostly yellow; non-showy yellow flowers in late spring yields fleshy berries; grows from 6" to 12" tall & wide; good for erosion control; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in full to partial sun & moist to wet soils along or slightly in waterways; Asian native; Zones 5 - 8</i> | | | 2g | |
| Agastache 'Mango Tango' Hyssop-Anise; Hummingbird Mint <i>PERENNIAL; light peach to dusty orange bottlebrush-like flowers from mid-summer to early fall which cover the top half of the plant; compact upright habit to 18" tall by 15" wide; good cut flower; attracts butterflies & hummingbirds; tolerant of drought, rabbits & deer browse; locate in full sun & slightly alkaline well-drained moisture retentive soil; North American native; Zones (5) 6 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Agastache 'Peachie Keen' Hyssop-Anise; Hummingbird Mint <i>PERENNIAL; apricot-peach bottlebrush-like flowers from mid-summer to early fall which cover the top half of the plant; purplish-pink calyxes extend the ornamental display into late fall; compact rounded habit to 24" tall by 30" wide; aromatic bright green flower; good cut flower; attracts butterflies & hummingbirds; tolerant of drought, rabbits & deer browse; locate in full sun & slightly alkaline well-drained moisture retentive soil; North American native; Zones (5) 6 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Ajuga 'Black Scallop' Purple Bugleweed <i>GROUND COVER; PERENNIAL; oversized very dark purple foliage contrasts with bright blue flowers in June on a low groundcover; makes dense mats that can be aggressive; can be spaced up to 3' apart; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; tolerates Black Walnuts; needs good drainage & air circulation to prevent Crown Rot; locate in full to partial shade & well-drained soils, but is adaptable; European native; Zones 4 - 11</i> | | | 2g | |
| Ajuga 'Caitlin's Giant' Bugleweed <i>GROUND COVER; PERENNIAL; large bronze foliage; dark purple flower spikes in mid spring; 8-10" tall; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; tolerates Black Walnuts; needs good drainage & air circulation to prevent Crown Rot; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained soils, but is adaptable; European native; Zones (3) 4 - 8 (9)</i> | | | 2g | |
| Ajuga reptans 'Burgundy Glow' Bugleweed <i>GROUND COVER; PERENNIAL; pink, white & green foliage under 12"; blue flowers on 6' spikes in late spring; aggressive grower; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; tolerates Black Walnuts; needs good drainage & air circulation to prevent Crown Rot; locate in full to partial shade & well-drained soils, but is adaptable; European native; Zones 3 - 10</i> | | | 1g | N |
| Amsonia 'Blue Ice' Blue Star <i>PERENNIAL; medium lavender-blue flowers in early spring for about 5 weeks; spreading mounding groundcover to 15" high by 2' wide; dark green summer foliage turns bright yellow in the fall; needs adequate moisture; locate in full sun to partial shade & moist well-drained soil; somewhat tolerant of drought, excessive moisture & deer browse (White Flower Farm) Zones 5 - 9</i> | | | 2g | N |
| Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Massachusetts' Kinnickinnick; Bearberry <i>EVERGREEN GROUND COVER; pinkish-white flowers in April; red fruit appears in late summer; resistant to leaf spot & gall; needs well drained neutral to acidic infertile soil; full sun to partial shade; slow spreading habit to 12" tall; will tolerate light foot traffic & coastal sites; eastern US native (Tichnor) Zones 2 - 7 (8)</i> | | | 1g | |

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| Aronia arbutifolia 'Brilliantissima' Red Chokeberry <i>DECIDUOUS FLOWERING SHRUB; upright suckering shrub to 10'; white flowers in May; brilliant red fall foliage; persistent red fruit; glossy dark green summer foliage; locate in full sun to part shade; tolerant of most soils that don't stay wet; eastern US native; PHS Gold Metal; Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 3g | |
| Aronia melanocarpa 'Autumn Magic' Black Chokeberry <i>DECIDUOUS FLOWERING SHRUB; masses of small white flowers in May; large persistent black fruit into winter; glossy dark green summer foliage turns brilliant purplish-red in the fall; broadly upright habit to about 6' tall by 7' wide; spreads by root suckers; locate in full sun to part shade & well-drained to boggy soils that don't stay wet; eastern US native (U of British Columbia) Zones 3 - 8 (9)</i> | | | 3g | |
| Artemesia 'Silver Mound' Wormwood <i>PERENNIAL; finely cut lacy silver foliage; compact mounding habit to 10" tall by 15" wide; insignificant flowers & fruit; locate in full sun to light shade & very well-drained soil with minimal fertility; drought tolerant; Japanese native [A. schmidtiana] Zones 5 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Bridal Veil' White Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; white flowers in June & July; grows to 30" tall; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in light to partial shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; Asian native [A. x arendsii] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Delft Lace' Pink Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; salmon-pink buds open to soft apricot-pink flowers from late spring into early summer to stout red stems; grows to 3' high & wide; deep waxy blue-green foliage has silvery overtones; locate in light to partial shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; seedling of unknown origin (AB-Cultivars) Zones 5 - 7</i> | | | 2g | N |
| Astilbe 'Fanal' Red Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; blood red plumes; mid-season; 24" tall; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in light to partial shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; Asian native [A. x arendsii] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 1g 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Henny Graafland' Pink Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; shell-pink plumes in mid to late summer; dark green finely cut foliage; 15" tall by 12" wide; improved 'Sprite'; resists deer & rabbit browse; locate in mostly sunny to mostly shady locations & rich organic neutral to acidic moisture retentive soil with adequate drainage; Asian native [A. simplicifolia] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Ostrich Plume' Pink Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; arching plumes of pink flowers to 3' tall in early summer; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in light to partial shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; Asian native [A. x arendsii] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Peach Blossom' Pink Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; salmon pink plume; early; 24"; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in light to partial shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; Asian native [A. x arendsii] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |

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| Astilbe 'Perkeo' Dwarf Pink Plume Flower <i>PERENNIAL; small dark pink flowers in mid to late summer above the foliage; compact mound to 8" tall by 12" wide; crinkly dark green foliage emerges reddish-bronze in late spring; resists deer & rabbit browse; locate in light to mostly shady locations & rich organic neutral to acidic moisture retentive soil with adequate drainage; Asian native [A. x crispa] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Visions' Pink Chinese Astilbe <i>PERENNIAL; abundant fragrant mauve-pink flowers in July & August; 15" tall; resistant to deer & rabbit browse; locate in light to partial shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; Asian native [A. chinensis] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | N |
| Astilbe 'Visions in Pink' Pink Chinese Astilbe <i>PERENNIAL; pink flowers in early summer; bushy habit to 18" high & wide; resistant to deer & rabbit browse & Black Walnuts; locate in light to moderate shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; more sun & drought tolerant than other Astilbes; Asian native [A. chinensis] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Visions In Red' Red Chinese Astilbe <i>PERENNIAL; purplish-red flowers in early summer; bushy habit to 2' high by 18" wide; resistant to deer & rabbit browse & Black Walnuts; locate in light to moderate shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; more sun & drought tolerant than other Astilbes; Asian native [A. chinensis] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | |
| Astilbe 'Visions In White' White Chinese Astilbe <i>PERENNIAL; white flowers in early summer; bushy habit to 18" high & wide; resistant to deer & rabbit browse & Black Walnuts; locate in light to moderate shade & consistently moist (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; more sun & drought tolerant than other Astilbes; Asian native [A. chinensis] Zones 4 - 9</i> | | | 2g | N |
| Astilbe Yonique Salmon ('Verssalmon') Pink Hybrid Astilbe <i>PERENNIAL; floriferous fluffy salmon-pink flowers from early to mid-summer on sturdy stems; grows to 2' high & wide; glossy deep green fernlike foliage that turns orange-tan in late fall; improved disease resistance; attracts butterflies; deer & rabbit browse resistant; locate in light to partial shade & moisture retentive (but not waterlogged) rich organic soils; increased drought tolerance but not drought resistant (Ball / Darwin) Zones 3 - 8</i> | | | 2g | |
| Athyrium filix-femina var. angustum 'Lady In Red' Lady Fern; Common Lady Fern <i>FERN; grows to 30" tall in full to partially shady areas with rich loamy humus-rich soils; light green deciduous fronds appear on dark reddish-violet stipes (stems); compact spreading clumps; grows in boggy soils; more tolerant of sun & drought than most other ferns, although not considered a drought tolerant plant; native of eastern & Midwestern US; deer browse resistant; from the New England Wildflower Society; Zones 4 - 8</i> | | | 1g 2g | |
| Athyrium 'Ghost' Variegated Lady Fern <i>FERN; new fronds appear throughout the summer & are silver-white, which fades to green; decidedly upright habit to 3' tall; deer browse resistant; locate in full to partial shade & moist organic well-drained acidic soil (Swell) Zones 4 - 8</i> | | | 1g 2g | N |

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| Athyrium nipponicum 'Pictum' Japanese Painted Fern <i>FERN; lacy fronds are silver on the edges with green shades & maroon to purple centers; grows to 18" high by 24" wide; resistant to deer & rabbits; locate in shade with high organic well-drained soil that's neutral to slightly acidic; Asian native; Zones (3) 4 - 8</i> | | | 1g 2g | |
| Aucuba japonica 'Hosoba Hoshifu' Variegated Japanese Aucuba <i>BROADLEAF EVERGREEN SHRUB; inconspicuous flowers in spring; long narrow glossy foliage generously speckled with bright yellow spots; female cultivar produces large persistent bright red drupes in fall which remain effective through winter; most variegated Aucubas are male; a male cultivar needs to be close by to produce fruit; grows to about 5' high by 4' wide; locate in full to moderate shade with moist highly organic well-drained soils; protect from winter winds; native of Japan; Zones (6) 7 - 10</i> | | | 3g | |
| Aucuba japonica 'Mr. Goldstrike' Variegated Japanese Aucuba <i>BROADLEAF EVERGREEN SHRUB; dark glossy green foliage generously splashed with yellow specs; small white flowers not especially significant; male cultivar; locate in shade with moist highly organic well drained soils; protect from winter winds; native of Japan; Zones (6) 7 - 10</i> | | | 3g | N |
| Aucuba japonica 'Serratifolia' Sawtooth Japanese Aucuba <i>BROADLEAF EVERGREEN SHRUB; dark green serrated evergreen foliage; bushy habit to 6' tall & wide; red fruit clusters from fall into winter; locate in shade with moist highly organic well drained soils; protect from winter winds; tolerant of coastal conditions; native of Japan; Zones (6) 7 - 10</i> | | | 3g | |
| Aucuba japonica 'Variegata' Gold Dust Plant; Variegated Japanese Aucuba <i>BROADLEAF EVERGREEN SHRUB; dark green foliage with generous specks of gold throughout; locate in shade with moist highly organic well-drained soils; protect from winter winds; native of Japan; Zones (6) 7 - 10</i> | | | 3g 7g | |
| Azalea 'Conversation Piece' Pink Robin Hill Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 4" single pink, white and bicolor flowers in late season; low spreading habit; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Robin Hill Hybrid; Zones (5) 6 - 9</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Delaware Valley' White Evergreen Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 2 1/4" single pure white flowers in early midseason; compact spreading mound to 4' high & wide; attracts butterflies; resists rabbit browse; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in full sun to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Glenn Dale Hybrid; - 20° F</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea Girard's Fuchsia' Purple Girard Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 2.5-3" single ruffled reddish-purple flowers in midseason; broadly compact habit to 3' in 10 yrs.; dark, glossy olive green foliage turns reddish in winter; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; ROY 2008 (Girard N) (- 15° F) - 10° F</i> | | | 3g | |

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| Azalea 'Gumpo Pink' Pink Satsuki Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 2 1/2" single pink flower with varying shades in early June; dwarf spreading mound to 12" tall by 18" wide in 10 years; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Satsuki Hybrid; Zones (6) 7 - 9</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Gumpo White' White Satsuki Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 2 1/2" single white flower in early June; dwarf spreading mound to 12" tall by 18" wide in 10 years; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Satsuki Hybrid; Zones (6) 7 - 9</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Hershey's Red' Red Hershey Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 2" hose-in-hose bright red flowers early to mid season; medium habit; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Kurume Hybrid; - 20° F</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Hino Crimson' Red Kurume Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 1" single scarlet-red flowers in early mid-season; compact & sun tolerant; glossy green foliage turns dark red in fall; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in full sun to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Kurume Hybrid (Vermeulen) Zones 5 - 8</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Nancy of Robin Hill' Pink Robin Hill Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 3 1/2" double & hose-in-hose soft pink flowers in late mid season; dark olive green foliage; broadly compact habit; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; Robin Hill Hybrid (Gartrell) - 10° F</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Pleasant White' White Evergreen Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 3" single white flower in mid to late season; medium habit; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; - 20° F</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Renee Michelle' Pink Evergreen Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; bright pink 2 1/2" single flower in mid-late season; rounded mounding habit; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; - 10° F</i> | | | 3g | |
| Azalea 'Silver Sword' Variegated Red Evergreen Azalea <i>EVERGREEN FLOWERING SHRUB; 2" hot pink to purplish-red flowers in midseason; dark foliage with thin creamy white edge gets reddish hews in fall through winter; broadly upright bushy habit to 2' tall in 10 yrs.; must be planted high, with the top of the root mass at least 10% of its' height above the adjacent soil level; locate in light to moderate shade & deep organic well-drained moisture retentive acidic soils; (- 5° F) 0° F</i> | | | 3g | |
